

Waste to Energy Conversion Symposium in the Caribbean

A symposium on '*Options for Jamaica's Energy Security: A Focus on Waste to Energy Conversion*' was held at the Courtleigh Hotel in Kingston Jamaica. One of the purposes of the symposium was to promote private and public sector cooperation between The Red Energy Group - a United States-based alternative energy company that specializes in the development and delivery of renewable energy technologies and Jamaica. The Red Energy Group has a Catalytic DE polymerization Procedure (CDP) technology, which converts waste materials to fossil free fuel.

The group is exploring the possibility of constructing a waste-to-energy plant in Jamaica, capable of supplying the national grid with 3.5 megawatts (MW) and producing an environmentally friendly diesel, which is superior to regular diesel.
